Accommodation at school

Most teams will stay overnight at a local school in the area. Frydenhøjskolen is the largest school used for the tournament, with good parking possibilities for both cars and buses. This school is also selected as the check-in school. Check-in will be open on Friday 22 May from 16:00–21:00.

Addresses of the selected schools:

Frydenhøjskolen: Ege volden 106, 2650 Hvidovre

Avedøre Skolen: Frydenhøjstien 4, 2650 Hvidovre (walking distance to playing fields)

Langhøjskolen: Hvidovre Strandvej 70A, 2650 Hvidovre

When staying at the school, it is important that players, coaches and supporters show respect for the school's facilities and equipment. Classrooms are the students' daily workspace and must be left in the same condition as received.



Important rules for accommodation

- Show respect for furniture and equipment
- Smartboards must NOT be used
- Football boots are not allowed indoors
- Ball games are not allowed indoors
- Schools will be locked between 10:00–17:00

There will be guards and volunteers present during opening hours and throughout the night. Please contact them if you need help. At some schools there will also be a small kiosk run by volunteers where snacks, sweets and drinks can be purchased.

For the benefit of all guests and neighbours:

- Loud music is not allowed between 22:00–08:00

In case of fire or evacuation, please familiarise yourselves with emergency exits and safety instructions upon arrival.

Emergency services can be contacted by dialing 112 – only in case of real emergency

Classroom at departure

In your welcome envelope, you will find a picture showing how the classroom must be left at departure (Sunday or Monday). The same picture is posted on the classroom door.

At departure remember:

- Dispose of waste in containers
- Sweep the room
- Return tables and chairs correctly
- Leave the room clean and tidy

This is required to receive your deposit back.

Depositum

All teams staying at schools pay a deposit of **100 Euro** (approx. 800 DKK). The deposit will be refunded when the classroom is approved by a tournament representative at departure. A representative will be present at all schools



Tournament area – Avedøre Stadium

Avedøre Stadium is the center of Copenhagen Cup and has been transformed into a small tournament village with:

- Food area
- Merchandise shop
- Tournament office
- Event area
- Social spaces

Here you can relax between matches and enjoy the international tournament atmosphere.

Shower and changing facilities are also available.

Please:

- Leave changing rooms clean
- Leave shower areas tidy (no guarantee of showers at schools)
- Keep your team area clean
- Use the bins placed around the area
- Leave toilets clean for the next users

In Denmark we sort waste to protect the environment. Waste stations are set up for separate collection of bottles and cans. We hope everyone will help keep the area clean and support a more sustainable tournament. Together we take care of facilities, nature and the environment

Award ceremonies take place Sunday on the main grass area near the food area. UEFA Respect ceremonies will take place between 13:00–16:00. Participants receive medals on stage.



Prizes are awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place.

Wristbands must be shown when having Breakfast and Dinner.

As many participants are gathered at the same time, we ask everyone to show patience, consideration, and respect for one another.

We also encourage everyone not to occupy tables longer than necessary, so there is room for other teams as well.
